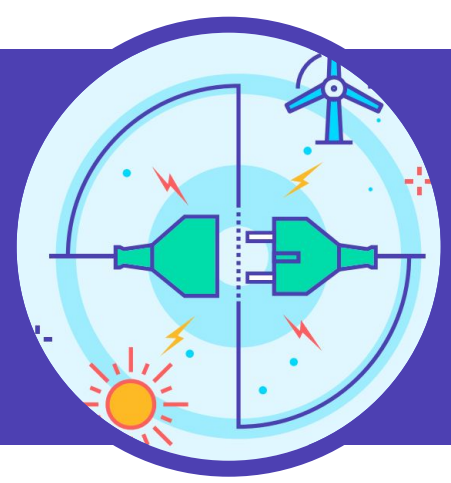

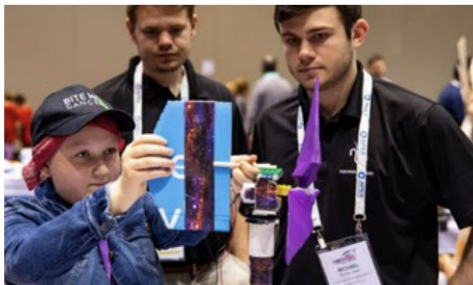
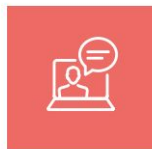


Phoenix, AZ | May 18th-21st

To qualify, each year the top teams from national and international wind and solar events as well as the online wind and solar challenges are invited to participate in the World KidWind Challenge. KidWind Worlds is a large and prestigious in-person event, hosted at a conference center in a different U.S. state every year.

Competition Elements

- Judging session
- Wind turbine or solar home testing
- Instant Challenges
- Quizbowl



Steps to Participate

Step 1. Receive an invite! Top performing teams at in-person and online Challenges receive invites. Top performers in the Simulation Challenge (who submit a physical turbine) will also receive an invite to Worlds.

Step 2. Check the [KidWind Worlds page](#) for dates and information.

Step 3. Coaches complete the Worlds registration form (included in their team's invitation). ALL attendees complete an Attendee Form and Liability and Media Release Form.

Step 4. Book flights or transportation and lodging.

Step 5. Raise money!

Step 6. Attend the event with your teams' wind turbine and presentations.
